Overview

Unfortunately, these hospitals have suffered due to a history of poorly managed Asbestos removal, whereby previous Asbestos removal processes were not completed to sufficient standards. This has resulted in reputational damage and costly long term maintenance issues. Searching for the final solution, the trust contacted Kier for advice. The types of Asbestos encountered ranged from insulation board debris within ceiling voids to spray coatings to structural beams. Destructive techniques were sometimes required to gain access to voids and risers, in order to make sure the project was conducted thoroughly and efficiently.
